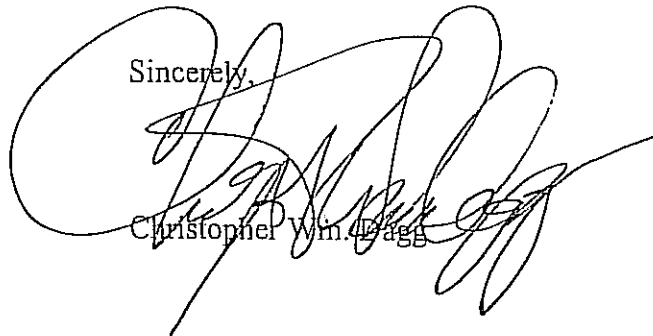

Dear Mr. Dagg:

We have received a request from your client, Eloise [REDACTED] regarding information on how to correct her name on her birth record. She asked that we contact you with this information.

Her birth record was filed showing her name as Roxy [REDACTED]. There have been no changes to the record. It is possible to change the names with an affidavit and documentary evidence that was established prior to her eighteenth birthday that shows her given names as Eloise [REDACTED].

Enclosed is an Affidavit for Correction of a Record that can be signed by your client in the presence of a notary public. As stated above, documentary evidence that supports the correction is required. The evidence **must** be a record established before her eighteenth birthday. A list of examples of the types of documents that are acceptable as evidence is on the reverse side of the affidavit.

If she cannot provide acceptable documentary evidence, it would be necessary for this office to receive a court order authorizing the change in order to change the name on the certificate to show her name as Eloise [REDACTED].

The fee for a certified copy of a birth record is \$12.00. There is also a \$10.00 administrative fee to make any corrections or amendments to a vital record. Complete the enclosed application and return it with the required fee for a certified copy of the record.

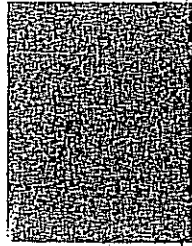

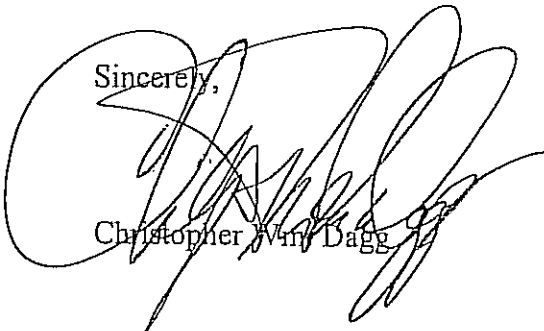

AFFIDAVIT

ELOISE [REDACTED], being duly sworn, hereby deposes and states the following under penalty of perjury:

1. I was born on October 1, 1931, in La Crosse, Virginia. My parents were Robert and Gladys [REDACTED]. My mother's maiden name was [REDACTED].
2. My given name is and always has been Eloise and that is the name I have always used and been known as.
3. I have never gone by the name "Roxy" and have no idea why that name is on my birth certificate.
4. My attorney has informed me that correcting my birth certificate would be very difficult and time-consuming. To do it, I would need to sign an affidavit swearing that Eloise is my correct first name and provide additional evidence in the form of a document established before my 18th birthday showing my correct name.
5. The Census Bureau Report from 1940, when I was eight years old, that my attorney obtained on my behalf has me listed as "Elouise", but that is a misspelling.
6. The Virginia Department of Vital Records has informed my attorney that if we use the Census Report, the corrected birth certificate would have to use "Elouise," but that is not correct, either. Alternatively, I could go to court in Virginia to legally change my name from Roxy to Eloise, but I cannot afford to hire an attorney to do that or to travel from Brooklyn.

7. My maiden name is Evans. I have been married three times. My first marriage was to Charles J. [REDACTED] on December 28, 1957, in Brooklyn. Whoever wrote out my information on the marriage certificate incorrectly put down October 2, 1931, as my birthday, when it is actually October 1st, 1931. I took [REDACTED] as my last name.

8. Charles and I divorced in the 1960s.

9. My second husband was Joseph [REDACTED]. We married on August 19, 1967, in Maryland. I was 35 at the time. I do not know why the marriage certificate says I was 33. I changed my last name to [REDACTED] but continued to use [REDACTED] as a middle name.

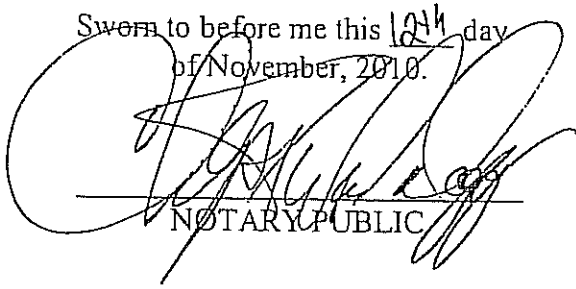
10. Joseph and I divorced after only six months or so.

11. My third and last marriage was to Thomas [REDACTED]. We got married in Queens on March 11, 1973. I changed my last name again, this time to [REDACTED]. We remained married until his passing in 1985.

12. I have not remarried or changed my name since my marriage to Thomas. My driver's license, lease, bank accounts, etc., are all in the name of Eloise [REDACTED], my legal name and the name I have used since 1973.
